Guard 2000 is a sticker-extender adjuvant, used to improve rain-fastness, improve foliar coverage and retention, while protecting against UV degradation, evaporation loss and assist in the reduction of spray drift. Guard 2000 works by way of reducing surface tension, allowing the spray droplets to spread over the leaf to cover a larger area, ensuring greater coverage & improved drying. Guard 2000 can be mixed with a wide range of agrichemicals and foliar fertilisers for use on crops.

WARNING: This product should not be swallowed or inhaled.

FIRST AID: If swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. If splashed in eyes, wash out immediately with water.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Avoid skin and eye contact and inhalation of spray mist. When mixing or applying wear waterproof gloves, eye protection, boots and overalls. DO NOT eat, drink or smoke while using. Wash splashes of concentrate from skin immediately. Remove protective clothing and wash hands and face thoroughly before meals and after work. Wash protective clothing daily after work.

STORAGE: Store in original container, tightly closed and in a dry, cool area away from direct sunlight and foodstuffs. Protect from frost, store above 5 °C.

DISPOSAL: Triple rinse empty container and add rinsate to the spray tank. If recycling, discard cap and deliver clean container to an Agrecovery depot. Alternatively crush and bury in a suitable landfill. Dispose of product only by using according to the label, or at an approved disposal facility.

APPLICATION RATE:

Use Headland Guard 2000 at 0.1% of total spray volume (100 ml per 100 litres of water or pro rata).

MIXING:

Shake the container well before use. Prepare the pesticide spray in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Add the required amount of Headland Guard 2000 to the spray mix as the last operation. Maintain agitation whilst mixing, traveling and spraying. Clean up equipment thoroughly after use.

COMPATIBILITY:

Headland Guard 2000 is compatible with most foliar applied pesticides. Consult your distributor for the latest information.
